Master's Degree in Secondary Education Teaching, Professional Training and Language Teaching

Description

This Master's Degree provides initial training for the teaching profession, combining theoretical knowledge, skills, attitudes, and sufficient contact with professional practice. Additionally, depending on elective choices, it may offer basic training in educational research within a specific disciplinary area, closely linked to research lines in education and doctoral programs. It is an ideal Master's program for teacher training and research in specific didactics, educational guidance, as well as general educational topics related to Secondary Education.

Admission Profile

Applicants must hold a Spanish degree or another qualification issued by a Higher Education Institution within the European Higher Education Area, aligned with the specialization they wish to pursue.

The program is structured into different specializations designed to ensure optimal coherence between the proposed curriculum and the students' prior undergraduate degrees. Admission also requires proof of proficiency in any European language other than Spanish at least at a B1 level according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).

For international students wishing to enrol, it is recommended to have a Spanish level equivalent to B2 according to the CEFR.

Career Opportunities

This official Master's Degree qualifies graduates to work as teachers in Compulsory Secondary Education,

Upper Secondary Education (Bachillerato), Professional Training and Language Teaching. It is a basic requirement for teaching in public, charter and private educational institutions.
